The American Academy of Pediatrics is pleased to announce the fifth cycle of the Community Access to Child Health (CATCH) Implementation Funds Program. The program supports pediatricians in the initial and/or pilot stage of developing and implementing a community-based child health initiative. This program is for pediatricians who will work with local communities to ensure that all children have medical homes and access to any needed health care services. A pediatrician must lead the project and be involved in proposal development and project activities. Priority will be given to projects serving communities with the greatest demonstrated health care access needs and health disparities. Strong collaborative community partnerships and future sustainability of the project are encouraged.

Grants are provided in amounts from \$2,500 to \$10,000 for pediatricians to initiate innovative, community-based proposals to increase children's access to health care. The grant cycle starts November 1, 2006, with an application deadline of January 31, 2007.
