

Bills Update, 3/31

SB427, Booster Seats: Still waiting for conference members to be named.

SB3101, Early Learning Authority, authorized to oversee the development of the early childhood learning program for children 0 to 8 years.

Passed FIN. Will go to conference.. Testimony submitted.

HB3237, Inter-departmental working group will develop the specifics of the early childhood learning program under the Early Learning Authority.

Passed WAM. Will go to conference. Testimony submitted.

SB2340 and SB2347, Early Intervention Services appropriations.

Will be heard by FIN on 4/3. Testimony submitted

HB3116, Health Insurance.

Will be heard by WAM for decision making on 4/3. Testimony sent.

HB2045, Perinatal Clinic. Will be heard by WAM on 4/4. Testimony sent.

SB2132, Perinatal Clinic. No progress but probably not needed because HB2045 advanced.

HB3154, Hg/Vaccines. Awaits hearing in HTH/HMS.

SB2133, Hg/Vaccines. Referred to FIN. If it passes FIN, it will go to conference. The Senate conferees will have a say. They can still take out part 3. Best for us will be if FIN doesn't hold a hearing.

HB3139, Screening prior to preschool entry. Referred to WAM.

SB3279, Relating to medical liability. Referred to House Judiciary.

HB2589, Psychologists prescribing authority. Referred to HLT, FIN.

We sent testimony to Honolulu County Medical Society to be used in their package of testimony.
