EPSDT provides Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment health services for individuals under age 21, through Hawaii QUEST, QUEST-Net and Medicaid Fee-For-Service programs.

EPSDT provides coverage for:

- ◆ complete medical and dental examinations
- ◆ hearing and vision tests, laboratory tests
- ◆ immunizations and skin tests for tuberculosis
- ◆ assistance with necessary scheduling and transportation upon request

There is no co-payment.

Regular health check-ups can keep you healthy!

What is EPSDT?

Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment **(EPSDT)** is a program that provides regular medical and dental checkups for individuals under age 21.

Why should EPSDT concern me?

Regular health checkups help to find physical and mental problems early before they become serious. It is important that you do all you can to keep your child healthy.

Who can use this program?

Individuals from birth to under age 21, if they have a medical plan card under Hawaii QUEST, QUEST-Net or a Medicaid Fee-For-Service card.

How do we receive EPSDT services?

Individuals under Hawaii QUEST or QUEST-Net get medical services from their health plans and dental services from dentists who see Medicaid clients. Individuals covered under the Medicaid Fee-For-Service Program get medical and dental services from doctors and dentists who see Medicaid clients.
