## **What is Neurotrauma Injury?**

In Hawai`i, neurotrauma injury is seen as a severe and chronic disability of a person that is attributable to an injury to the central nervous system, such as traumatic brain injury (TBI), spinal cord injury or stroke, and is likely to continue indefinitely.

## **What is Neurotrauma Supports?**

We are Neurotrauma Supports of the State of Hawai`i Department of Health's Developmental Disabilities Division. We provide leadership through community partnerships to promote neurotrauma injury prevention programs, education and public awareness.

## **Our Mission**

To develop, implement and monitor a comprehensive system of statewide supports to address the needs of people with neurotrauma injury and their families.

## **Services**

- We maintain a statewide telephone Helpline for information and referral.
- Provide assistance to neurotrauma injury survivors and their families to identify and obtain access to services.
- Maintain a Neurotrauma website providing information on frequently asked questions, resources on the various islands and a current calendar of events.
- Produce and distribute a quarterly Neurotrauma newsletter - call or e-mail us to join our mailing list!
- We provide educational and public awareness sessions and materials, through partnerships with other public and private organizations.
- Provide administrative and technical support to the State TBI and Neurotrauma Advisory Boards.
- Coordinate and monitor the Neurotrauma Special Fund.
- Assess the needs and concerns of neurotrauma injury survivors, their families, service providers, and other community stakeholders in order to develop the most responsive system of supports.
